We are not a large wedding venue and cater for a maximum of 95 guests.

The information below will give you some indication of what we are able to offer you, venue prices can be confusing and difficult to understand, sometimes with surprising hidden costs when you least expect them! We have tried to keep ours as simple as possible.

Ceremonies may take place in our beautiful Folly, or The Morning Room for which we hold a wedding licence.

We aim to plan the entire day around exactly what YOU want – some people prefer a small formal affair, others like something informal and slightly larger. We are more than happy to discuss any plans and ideas you may have.

For the Ceremony

The Folly will hold a maximum of 8 but usually the Bride, Groom and Registrar stand in the Folly. Additional guests may gather around the Folly so as to be included in the ceremony so numbers are not a problem.

The Morning Room holds 35 for an indoor ceremony.

If you would like the unique experience of Ashmount, but are planning a larger reception elsewhere, we are happy to accommodate this.

You may hold your ceremony, enjoy a glass of champagne and canapés and take photographs.

Please note you are welcome to throw confetti BUT please use Bio Degradable!!





Civil Ceremonies

Arranging your wedding

Once you have decided on your wedding date, please contact us to ensure that it is available. A provisional booking will then be made, after confirmation with the Registrar we will then require a deposit and written confirmation of your booking details.

Couples must confirm that the Registrar is available to conduct the ceremony on the day and time in question. This can be arranged up to 12 months in advance of the marriage and should be done as soon as possible.

Costs in addition are the attendance fee by the Registrar and payable direct to the Registry office.

The All Day Option - Sunday to Thursday

Ashmount Country House and Gardens are available for the use of the Wedding Party 11.30am – 5pm

This option is available to resident and non resident guests. Sunday – Thursday excluding Bank holidays. 11.30 – 5pm only
We can cater for up to 20 seated guests in the house 60 in a fully dressed Marquee

For an informal buffet 65 maximum numbers in the house 95 in a Marquee.

You may also like to have a string quartet or a jazz band etc

You may wish to have your ceremony in the morning followed by a champagne reception and wedding breakfast, with guests leaving by 5pm. Of course, any resident guests taking bedrooms for the night are more than welcome to sit and relax in the lounge for the remainder of the evening and enjoy a nightcap in front of the fire or out in the garden on summer nights.

No minimum number of rooms to be booked

Hosting of Ceremony and Venue hire £575

Smaller Weddings & Ceremonies

Beautiful ‘Simply Ceremony’ events can take place in the Morning Room and Folly Sunday - Thursday a 3 hour stay ensures ample time for photography and for drinks and canapés to be served after the ceremony.

Available Mondays to Thursdays (excluding bank holidays) £600

Costs in addition are the attendance fee by the Registrar and payable direct to the Registry office.

Suggested Itinerary

A Morning Wedding (non exclusive) All Day Option

Careful timing is essential on your Wedding Day and based on experience we suggest the following timetable.

11.30 am	Guests start to arrive Bridegroom meets with the Registrar to finalise details
11.50 am	The Registrar invites guests into the Ceremony room Bride arrives
12.00 noon	Ceremony takes place
12.30 pm	Drinks & Canapés Reception Time for photographs
1.00 pm	Guests are seated
1.15 pm	Wedding Breakfast is served
3.15 pm	Official Cake Cutting
3.30 pm	Speeches and Toasts Coffee & Wedding Cake
5.00 pm	Depart Ashmount Country House (This is a strict departure time for non-residents)

An Afternoon Wedding (exclusive use)

1.30 pm	Resident guests arrive and check into bedrooms (please note: As a general rule we cannot alter this time – normal check-in time 3.00pm)
3.00pm	Guests assemble. The Registrar will wish to finalise details with the Bridegroom
3.20 pm	The Registrar invites guests into the Ceremony Room The Bride arrives
3.30 pm	Ceremony Takes Place
4.00 pm	Drinks Reception with Canapés Time for photographs
6.00 pm	Wedding Breakfast served
8.00 pm	Official Cake Cutting Speeches and Toasts
9.30 pm	An optional Cheese Course may be offered
11.15 pm	Drinks service finishes
11.30 pm	Non residents depart

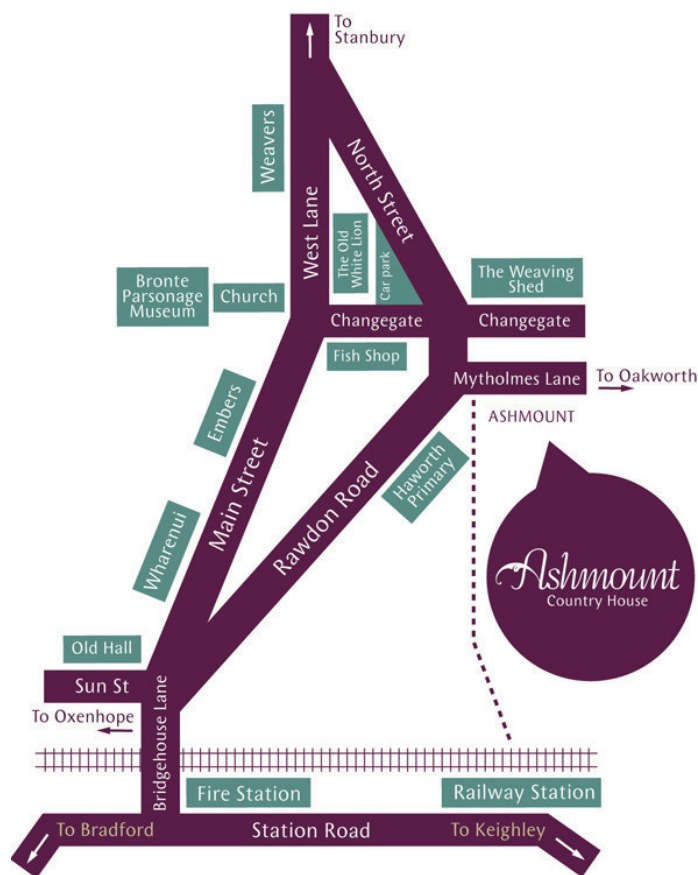




DETAILS OF HOW TO REACH US:

J26 take the A58 towards Halifax then the A644 towards Denholme and the A629 towards Keighley. When entering Haworth via the A629, A6033 and B6142 Lees Lane carry straight on past the Steam Train Station on the right, and continue. Bear right at the bottom of the main street and continue up the hill. You will pass a school on the right and a large medical centre on the left. Take the next right on to Mytholmes lane, and Ashmount Guest House is approx. 150 yards on the right.

By Train... From Leeds train station take the Skipton train to Keighley, once in Keighley a taxi can be taken from the train station up to Ashmount Country House for approx. £6.50 or a bus can be taken from the bus station in Keighley town centre to the top of Mytholmes Lane.



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Terms and Conditions

Booking conditions.-

1. Agreement

Unless otherwise agreed in writing by Ashmount Country House, no variations to the booking conditions will be effective.

2. Provisional booking

Once you have decided on the date of your wedding and your wedding requirements, we will make a provisional booking based on the anticipated number of guests. At this point we recommend that you reserve any rooms that will be required in Ashmount Country House.

3. Booking confirmation

In order to secure your booking we will need written confirmation of your requirements and a **(non-refundable)** deposit for £500.

Please note that a booking is provisional until your deposit has been received. Should another guest subsequently wish to book and confirm the same dates as your provisional booking, you will be requested to confirm your reservation immediately.

4. Balance of payment

One month before your wedding day we will require confirmation in writing of the total number of guests in your wedding party. At this point the balance of the total cost must be settled in full.

You will be liable to pay all extra charges incurred (any goods or services provided by Ashmount Country House on the day).

5. Lost property

Ashmount Country House shall not be liable for any loss or damage to property owned by, or in the custody of, you or your wedding party. You are advised to arrange adequate insurance cover.

6. Force majeure

Ashmount Country House will not be liable for any failure to comply with any contractual booking conditions to and by any cause beyond its control, including but not limited to fire, storm, explosion, flood, Act of God, action of any government or governmental agency.

7. Client's liability for damage

You shall be held liable for any damage or loss (including any costs or expenses arising thereby) suffered by Ashmount Country House as a result of the event.

8. Cancellation fees

If your reservation at Ashmount Country House has been confirmed in writing, and is then cancelled or postponed, the following charges will apply:

Up to one month's notice: the deposit will be retained and the full cost of any bedrooms cancelled must be paid.

Less than one month's notice: 100% of the confirmed bill and the full cost of any bedrooms cancelled must be paid.

All cancellations or changes in numbers must be confirmed in writing to Ashmount Country House, which in turn will be acknowledged in writing. (You are advised to consider insuring against potential cost of cancellation of the booking).

9. Use of Ashmount Country House

If you would like to bring electrical or any other equipment into Ashmount Country House, e.g. lighting etc. or anything that may be considered dangerous, please discuss this with us. Ashmount Country House will endeavour to meet any special requests indicated prior to the booking confirmation.

10. Noise

Please be aware we are part of a residential area and would ask guests to be mindful of this.

11. Entertainment policy

Music must be kept to an acceptable level and finish at 11.15pm

12. Non-smoking policy

Ashmount Country House enforces a strict non-smoking policy throughout the whole of the building.
